Managing Security

To ensure the school premises are a safe environment for children, school employees, visitors, parents/carers and students, for example by the use of CCTV, Security ID Cards, Visitor registration, Employee photographic displays. The types of personal information we need for this purpose include:

- Personal Images (Photographs)
- Name, vehicle registration (Visitor registration)

The purpose of this use of data is for public safety and the prevention of crime, and our legal basis for using the information in this way is a task in the public interest.

The Basildon Academies is the data controller. We may share this information with the Police or other certified investigators.

Closed Circuit Television Surveillance (CCTV)

The purpose of this use of data is for public safety and the prevention of crime, and our legal basis for using the information in this way is a task in the public interest.

The school is the data controller. We may share this information with the Police or other certified investigators.

To ensure the school premises are a safe environment for children, school employees, visitors and parents/ guardians by using CCTV.

The types of personal information we need for this purpose include:

- Personal Images (CCTV)
- Vehicle registration

The Academy operate CCTV records 24\7 for the safety of persons, crime prevention and security. Recorded data is automatically deleted after 30 days unless used for evidence.

We may share this data with the police or other official bodies.

Our visitor records will be held for seven years.

No personal information is routinely available outside of the UK. Should a transfer of personal information be necessary we will only do so where it is permitted by law and where appropriate safeguards are in place.
